2021 SEASON

“BOAT & BANK FISHING”

- 1) **With effect Saturday 20th March 2021 Boat & Bank Fishing at Llyn Cefni is permitted to members only.**
- 2) **Overriding priority is SAFETY. Safety to members, the general public and all stakeholders.**
- 3) Common sense prevails We do not have staff neither do we have a bailiff—YOU are responsible for your own safety, actions & hygiene.
- 4) The Hut & the toilet block will remain closed.
- 5) Car Park: Use the car park area wisely and park at least 2meters apart.
- 6) Members only to fish— no privilege vouchers to be used no day tickets nor Passport Scheme fishing. This is under the guidance of Dŵr Cymru (Welsh Water)
- 7) Visits to Llyn Cefni to be undertaken in accordance with current travel restrictions & social distancing guidelines as issued from time to time by the Welsh Government
- 8) All Cymdeithas Pysgota Cefni Angling Association Rules apply as do legal requirements to hold a valid NRW rod licence. It is mandatory that any person using a Club boat/vessel is wearing a correctly fitted and appropriate buoyancy aid/life jacket. Failure to do so will negate all insurance cover and liability of the Club
- 9) The cleaning of the gate, padlock and any common area that is touched is your responsibility to clean hygienically in accordance with Government guidelines <https://www.gov.uk/government/publications/covid-19-decontamination-in-non-healthcare-settings/covid-19-decontamination-in-non-healthcare-settings>
- 10) When fishing from the bank it is strongly advised to leave at least 15m between anglers
- 11) Only 1 person at the boat docking area at any one time (or in strict accordance with current social or physical distancing guidelines e.g. households & extended households)
- 12) One angler per boat in boat numbers 1; 3; 10; 15 & 17. Boat number 5 is a 16' boat allowing 2 anglers. On delivery (expected early April) boat numbers 6; 7 & 8 will also facilitate socially distanced 2 in a boat angling - all in strict accordance with current social or physical distancing guidelines e.g. households & extended households
- 13) **Cleaning of the boats (You are responsible for the provision & removal of all specified materials):**
 - a. If at all possible avoid taking a boat that has just been used—allow time for atmospheric cleansing.
 - b. NO sprays, liquids or chemicals to be used on or near the boats/water
 - c. Whilst hygienically cleaning the boats the wearing of protective gloves is advised
 - d. Hygienically clean the boat before and after use
 - e. 70% Alcohol IPA Isopropyl Alcohol based heavy duty wet wipes to be used to thoroughly wipe down all contact surfaces of the boat and oars
 - f. Used wipes (and gloves) should be sealed in a waterproof bag and taken home for appropriate disposal
 - g. Clean hands thoroughly with a hand sanitizer
